

### Future Leaders - Scholarship

The Our Legacy, Our Tomorrow Campaign will strengthen the Shevchenko Foundation's Education pillar, which seeks to increase and disseminate knowledge of all aspects of Ukrainian Canadian cultural heritage by supporting programming as well as educators and students alike. Education grant also helps to immerse students in the Ukrainian cultural experience. The Foundation's efforts are diverse and address all educational levels.

Through *Future Leaders*, the Shevchenko Foundation will support graduate students active in the Ukrainian Canadian community in furthering their professional studies in Canada.

Once *Future Leaders* is funded and established, exceptional students will be awarded scholarships annually towards their professional studies in the fields of medicine, dentistry, nursing, engineering, education, law, and business. Scholarship recipients will be selected based on their extra curricular involvement towards making their community a better place.

### Criteria

*Future Leaders* will award scholarships to students who demonstrate consistent and outstanding dedication to solving a community problem or making their community a better place in the Shevchenko Foundation's four pillars: arts, community development, education and/ or heritage.

For example, candidates may be working on an initiative that enriches the lives Ukrainian Canadians or improves organizations within the Ukrainian Canadian community. Candidates could also be leading a student organization for Ukrainian Canadians or fighting for a cause that affects the Ukrainian community at home or abroad.

*Future Leaders* was created for community-oriented students pursuing professional degrees or graduate degrees at Canadian post-secondary institutions.

#### **FUTURE LEADERS ELIGIBILITY**

Candidates must:

1. Be currently enrolled within a professional faculty at a post-secondary institution in Canada (medicine, dentistry, nursing, engineering, education, law and business and/ or a graduate studies program).
2. Produce proof of voluntary efforts in the community.
3. Be a Canadian citizen.

\* Individuals enrolled in an arts or liberal arts undergraduate program are not eligible.

#### **DISTRIBUTION**


The Shevchenko Foundation will send the recipient a cheque, in the amount of \$3,000, by certified mail after July 15th of the scholarship year.




## Shevchenko Foundation Grants to Date


The Shevchenko Foundation has granted \$10 million to date to support excellence in creativity and the promotion of Ukrainian Canadian culture.
